

DogsNZ Agility Standing Orders - Section 9

Appreciation Awards

The Agility Committee can at its absolute discretion award an Agility Committee Certificate of Appreciation to anyone who has contributed in a significant way over a sustained period of time to the benefit Nationally of our sport.

Criteria

The person nominated must have been involved in the sport for a period exceeding 10 years and must have been contributing to the sport for 10 years as a minimum.

Type of Involvement Recognised

The person must have been actively contributing to NZ Agility in

- local,
- regional and
- national roles.

The level of involvement must be over and above the normal level of involvement in each sector.

The person must have worked in a variety of different roles, benefitting many people. eg. acting as a volunteer, administrator, official etc.

They must show that they have served the sport rather than just served one club or one sector of it.

An example to others

The person nominated for this award should set a good example that others might like to follow. eg. Follow the rules, work hard, sportsmanship etc.

DogsNZ Awards

In addition, people can be nominated to DogsNZ for recognition via their COA certificates or in exceptional circumstances a nomination for life membership.
