Course Plans

NOTES.

These plans are 30m x 30m and so they can be laid out to fit a ring with an assembly area on either the 30m or 40m side.

ADX Advanced classes must include a minimum of three of the following obstacles:

Dog Walk, A-Frame, Crossover Ramp, See-Saw.

The rate of travel for ADX advanced is 3 m/s.

Hurdles including Brush or Blind Jump to only use One Bar and set at maximum height

Long jump must have corner poles

Weaves -12 poles must be used

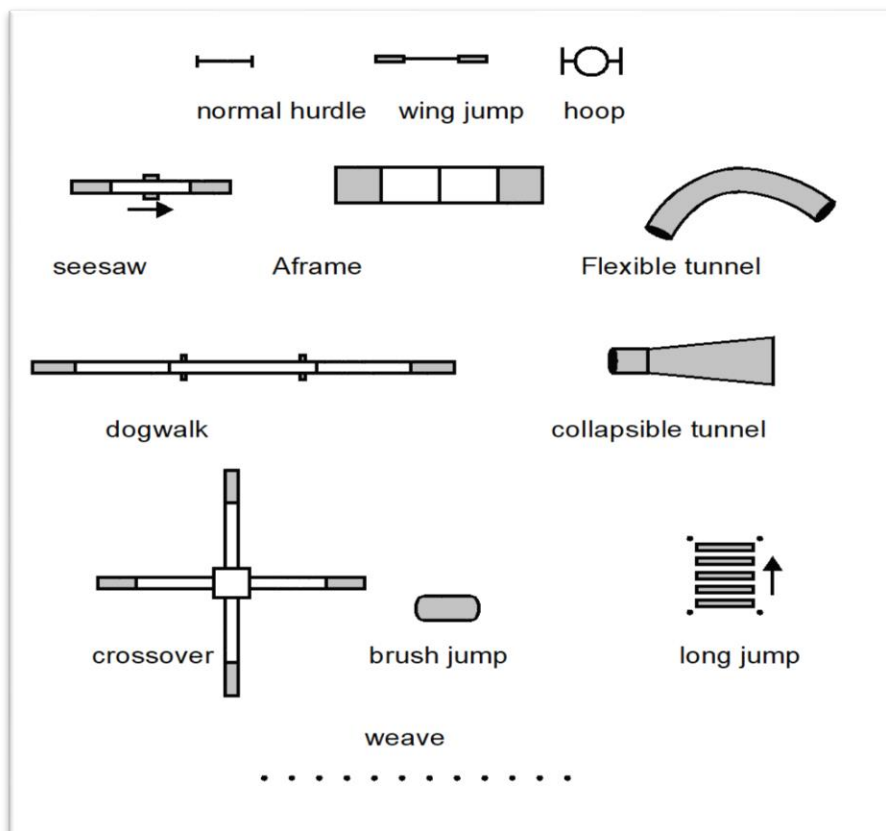
Pipe Tunnel – 500mm tunnel is used on plans

NB. Course #1,7,8 do not have collapsible tunnels in them, if a Club is concerned about wet weather causing safety concerns with this obstacle.

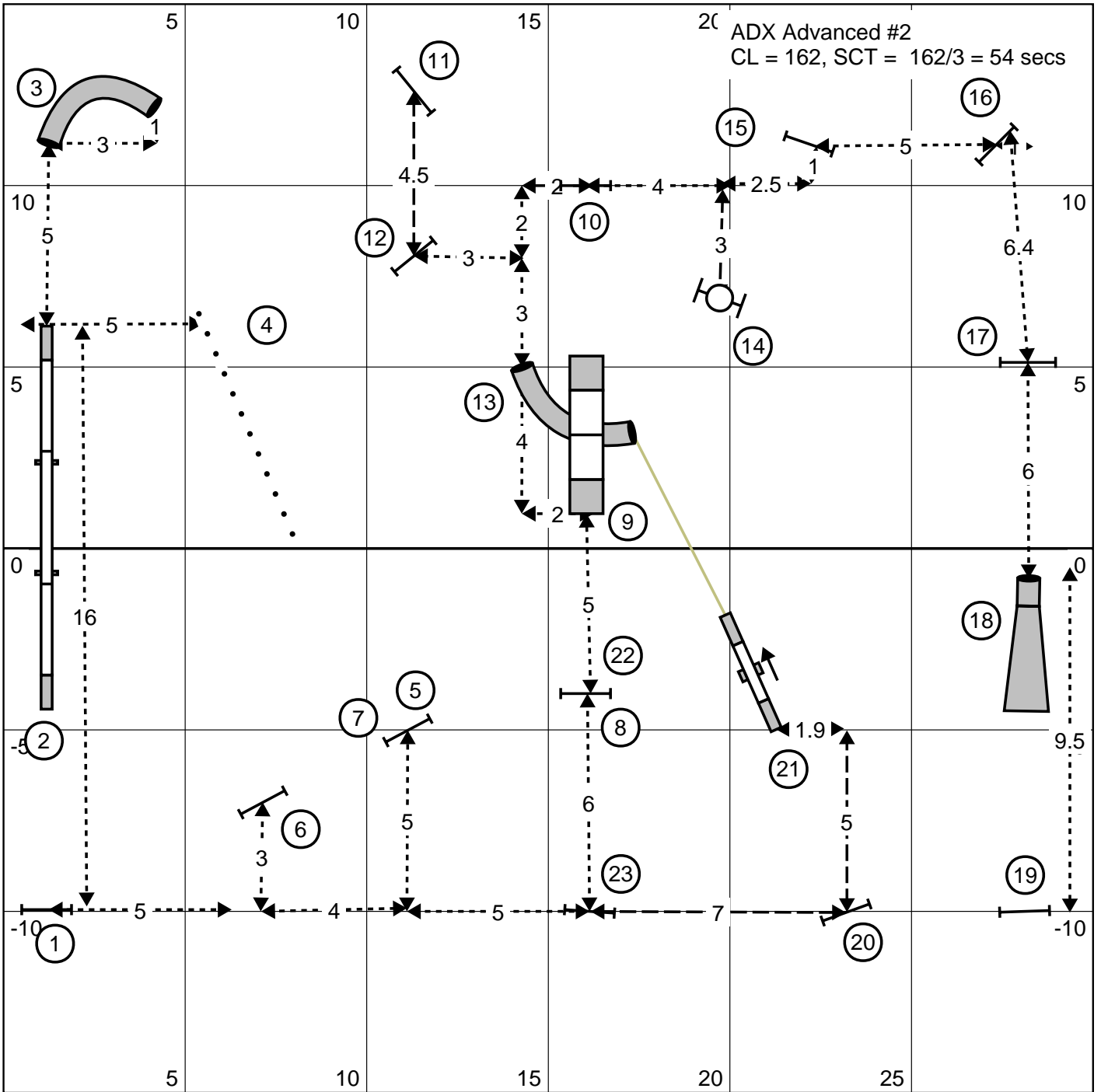
Start/Finish Timers - Electronic Timing must be used.

Course measuring - The course length should be measured using current methods. It is a guide to correct layout, and as such may not be exact. Care should be taken to ensure obstacles are set out correctly in relation to each other, and on correct angles and orientation to the next obstacle.

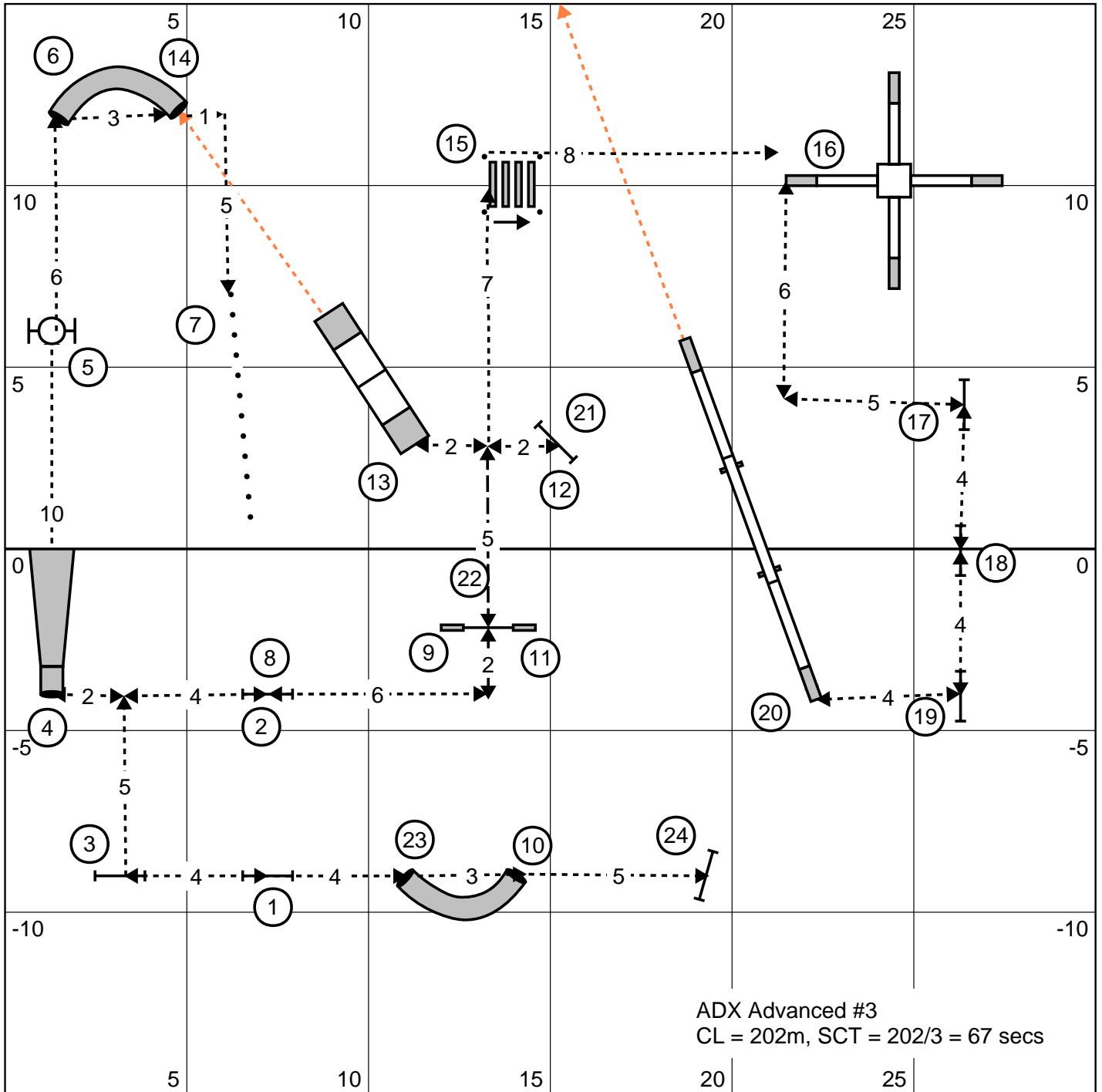
Individual measurements - should be as close as possible to that given, however a small variance due to individual obstacle variation is acceptable.



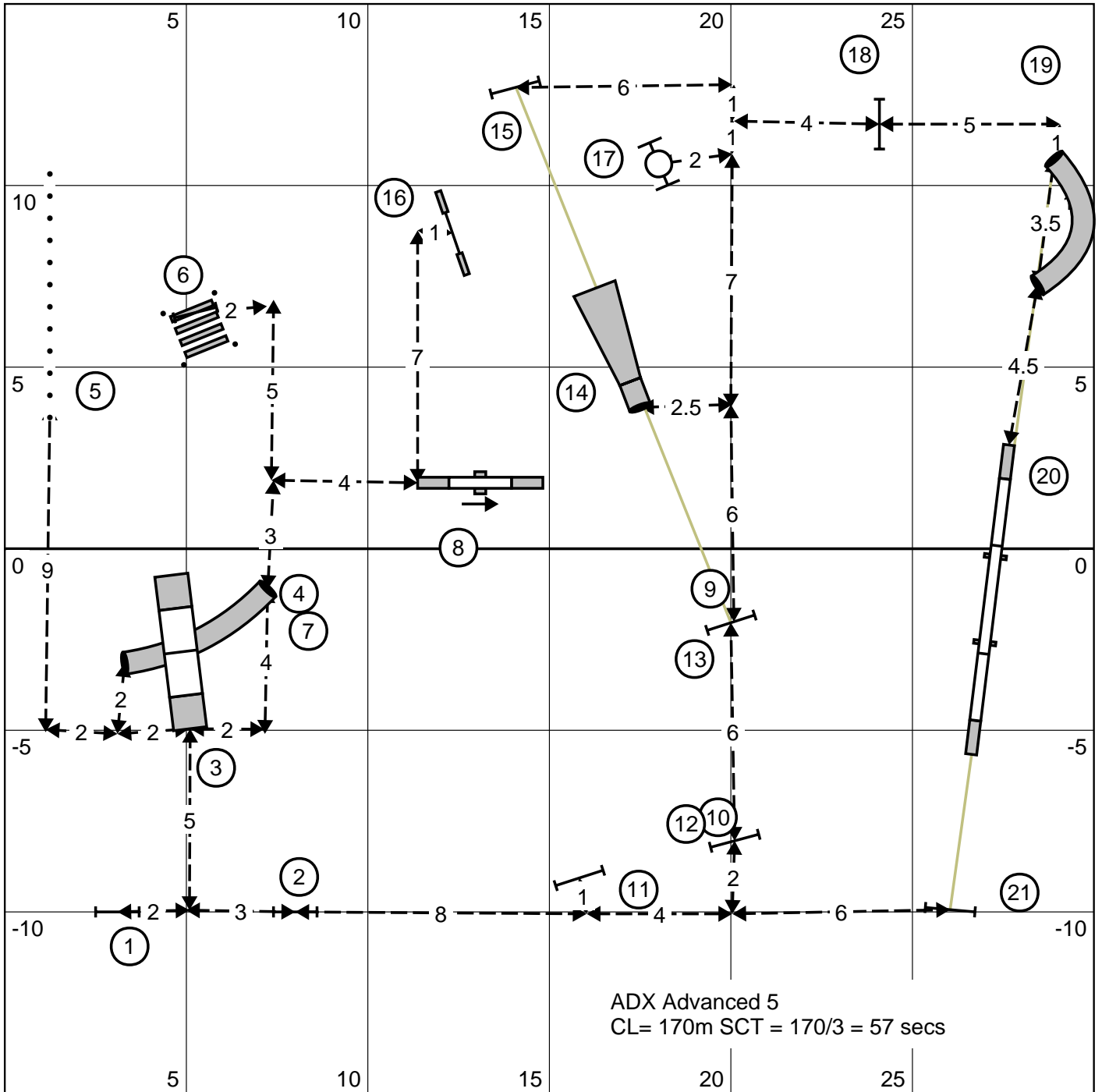
