

SHORT COURSES FOR AGILITY JUDGES.

To fulfil the requirements for attendance at a seminar or short course, the following can apply,

SHORT COURSE 1.

1. Complete one of the quizzes on safety, did you know the rules?
2. Design and submit 2 courses at either Int & Senior, or Intermediate and Jumpers A level. Mark your judging path on the course, and give it a SCT. List the various challenges that you have put into the course.

SHORT COURSE TWO.

1. Design a nested Novice and Senior course. For both - mark your judging path on the course, and give it a SCT. List the various challenges that you have put into the course. Comment on the different challenges between the two levels.
2. Complete one of the quizzes on safety, did you know the rules.

SHORT COURSE THREE.

1. Select 4 courses from the website at any level (one must be Senior) by any other Judge and make comments on
 - a. SCT
 - b. Judges path – where do you think the judges path should go, comment on its suitability.
 - c. Challenges – identify all the challenges in the course, comment on the number and suitability for the level.
 - d. Is the course appropriate for the level? Comment on this with reference to the number and level of challenges.
