

- A) Minor change to wording of SN award so that the title of regulation 8.1.3.3 matches the content (from SD to SN).

**8.1.3.3 Senior dog awards. (SN)**

There are four levels of Senior dog awards. A dog will qualify at each level after accumulating the required total of Championship clear round certificates. In ascending order, with number of certificates required, they are: -

Senior Dog – Excellent (SNX) – 25 certificates

Senior Dog – Bronze (SNB) – 40 certificates.

Senior Dog – Silver (SNS) – 55 certificates

Senior Dog – Gold (SNG) – 70 certificates

Qualifying certificates will be gained from January 2014

- B) Alteration to refer to another regulation rather than repeat the detail of it

**11.3.3 Standard Classes Split by Height Groups**

At every Ribbon Trial Event an individual Standard Class must be split **in the same manner as outlined in Regulation 11.1.2.1 above**

- C) Change to add specific tolerance to collapsed tunnel opening and add indication of dispensation on case by case basis.

**12.2.4 Collapsible Tunnel**

The Collapsible Tunnel consists of a section of Flexible Tunnel (the entrance section) to which a collapsing chute is attached, which extends in a straight line with the entrance section.

Overall length 3 metres. The entrance section shall make up 1.5 metres of the total length. Entrance diameter 700mm. The exit diameter must measure a minimum 600mm when the collapsed chute is anchored to the ground.

**Interim measure: Dispensation for existing tunnels with measurements outside this will be considered on a case by case basis. Application for dispensation to use tunnels outside of these measurements must be forwarded to the Agility Committee.**

**From January 2021, only those collapsible tunnels which conform to the specification detail above will be allowed to be used.**

**Tolerance on entrance section, overall length and entry diameter is 50mm each way.**

- D) Change to clarify that results in Elementary C do not impact the handler's ability to enter Elementary B or A at a later date

**14.1.1.1.2 Elementary B – Open to new handlers who are handling new dogs. A new handler is defined as the handler never having won an Elementary B or Elementary A class on a clear round, placed 1st to 3rd in any other standard agility class on a clear round or attained the title of AD or JD with any dog. Open to dogs that have never won an Elementary class on a clear round, placed 1st to 3rd in any other standard agility class on a clear round or attained the title of AD or JD.**
