

THREE OPTIONS – FEEDBACK.

The Heights Review Subcommittee (HRSC) would like to acknowledge that there is a high level of interest in the Options Report that has just been released. In order to help address the questions that are being posed on various threads, and to help ensure that the HRSC doesn't miss any constructive feedback we would like to advise the following:

- We received a huge amount of feedback in comments on Survey 1. We have summarised these in the Survey 1 report (add link). We have also referred to these in the Options report when explaining the rationale behind the revised scenarios. Please read these reports prior to posting questions and statements, as many of the answers can be found within these documents.
- The three revised scenarios are being put out for feedback and further survey. They address the most common feedback received as part of the first report. However they are not set in stone. The second survey is not a vote. It is a further opportunity to comment on a short list and give constructive feedback on what you like and don't like. The HRSC has not undertaken any of our work over the last 12 months with haste or without consultation with the agility community. We hope that the community will continue to be constructive and assist us in making a final recommendation.
- We recognise that people have questions about how splits will work with the Apple and Pear scenarios. The Agility Committee asked that splits were not included in this survey as the main role of the HRSC was to research a safe and fair jump height for all dogs. The AC will look into the fairest possible option for splits once the jump heights have been agreed.
- We will shortly open a [FB thread for questions on the three options](#) where people can pose questions to the HRSC regarding the revised scenarios. If people can use this thread it will help us keep a track of the queries, and also help you all see what others have already asked.
- We will hold a [webinar on Tuesday 10th July](#) to answer the questions that have been posed on the thread, and time permitting, any others that come up during the webinar. This will be recorded and posted to Youtube for those that aren't able to sit in on the 10th.
- Survey 2 will open the following week and we look forward to receiving further feedback from everyone. Please remember it is important to say what you do like, along with what you don't like, as that helps just as much with the decision making.
- Members of the HRSC committee have put in hundreds and hundreds of hours over the past year working on this review. We always knew that it would be impossible for every member of our sport (ourselves included) to be 100% happy with the outcome. However we can assure you that we are trying our very best to get an outcome that is safe and fair and far better than what we have now.
- As outlined in our previous reports, a final decision on the new heights system will sit solely with our Agility Committee.
